# BRIDGE CURBING

Available with either split or sawn front faces, NCGC Bridge Curbing comes with sawn bottom faces, straight and true front and back arris lines with no variance greater than 1/8", and at least two anchor holes in each unit: 3" deep, located 12" from each end pitched at approximately 45 degrees of angle.

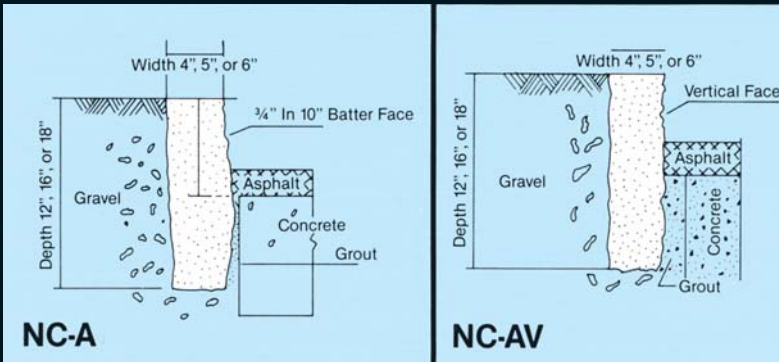

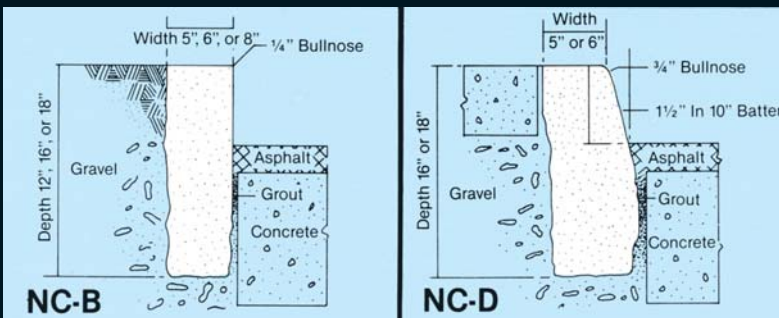
# SPLIT FACE CURBING

Split face curbing has smooth, quarry-split front face, no exposed drill holes, a depth tolerance of ±1", and no projections greater than 3/4" or depressions greater than 1/2" down to the paving line, below which no projections or depressions may exceed 1". Front arris lines are straight and true with no variance in excess of 1/8".



# SAWED FACE CURBING

The upper eight inches of the front face of this curbing can be either sawed or hammered with no projections or depressions greater than 1/8". The remainder of the front face will have no projection or depression greater than 1". Depth tolerance of ±1". Front arris lines will have a specified bullnose and back arris lines will be straight and true.
